

**CHAPEL HILL GARDEN CLUB
CONSTITUTION
REVISED October 2017**

Article I – Name

The organization shall be called The Chapel Hill Garden Club.

Article II – Objective

The objective of the Club shall be:

- (1) to educate its members to horticulture, floral design, landscape design, and sound environmental practice and
- (2) to encourage public and civic beautification and sound environmental practice through gardening.

Article III – Membership

Section 1. The membership categories of the club shall be active and life.

Section 2. All members are voting members.

Article IV – Officers and Elections

Section 1. The officers of the Club shall be:

President
1st Vice-President
2nd Vice-President
Recording Secretary
Corresponding Secretary
Treasurer
Parliamentarian
Council **and District*** Representative

Section 2. The officers shall be elected at the March meeting.

Article V – Meetings and State Authority

Section 1. The Club shall hold at least one meeting a month during the months from September through May.

Section 2. The annual meeting of the Club shall be in May.

Section 3. Any number of members present at any regular meeting shall have authority to transact business.

Article VI – Amendments

This constitution may be amended at any regular meeting by a two-thirds vote of the members present, provided notice of the proposed amendment has been submitted to the Club members at least thirty days prior to this regular meeting.
